

Raveries is a lens based phenomenology: an ongoing and variable-lenght-size video project that unfolds different cinematographic field recordings of intensive pathic-haptic sensations, sticky imprints of swarming presences glimpsed in everyday life, samples of chiasmic proliferations, infra-ordinary reveries catched by an anagogic camera that opens the iris diaphragm towards extrafoveal unforeseen embryonic apparitions.

Attempting to unlearn to recognize and to relearn to gaze, reacting to the blinding bulimic overexposure and compulsive iconomaniac media saturation, Raveries is a partisan stance against central geometric perspective order and it aims to dismember the gestalt principles of perceptual organization and to melt and dissolve subject-object dualism into an hermeneutical moebius loop so as to suggest a contemplative and immersive fusion. The pure tones of sine waves invite an ecstatic abandonment to moving images of pre-categorial, pre-narrative, pre-figural, undifferentiated and rarefied noise-grain of flow-matter.




